JON ANDERSON, PH.D.

President, Pennsylvania Western University

Dr. Jon Anderson began his tenure as the second president of Pennsylvania Western University (PennWest) on July 1, 2024, ushering in an exciting era of growth and innovation. A collaborative and forward-thinking academic leader, Dr. Anderson brings extensive experience in multi-campus leadership, with a strong focus on student success, budget optimization, enrollment strategies, and a shared institutional culture.

Prior to joining PennWest, Dr. Anderson served as provost and vice president for Academic Affairs for Southern Utah University and prior to that Middle Georgia State University. He spent more than a decade at the University of West Georgia as a member of the business faculty and in administrative positions including deputy provost, associate vice president, associate dean, accreditation liaison, and MBA director. In these roles, he has consistently taught undergraduate and graduate business courses and held faculty rank in business schools for two decades.

PennWest offers a diverse range of undergraduate and graduate programs across fields such as business, education, healthcare and the arts. With campuses in California, Clarion, and Edinboro—each with its own distinct history and traditions—the university also provides robust online learning opportunities through PennWest Global Online.

On December 6, 2024, Dr. Anderson was officially inaugurated as PennWest's second president, marking a

new chapter in the university's legacy of transformation and excellence. Dr. Anderson is focused on several key initiatives. These include advancing the university's strategic plan, successfully completing the Middle States Accreditation Review, and increasing enrollment.

As PennWest is a community-based institution of higher education, Dr. Anderson ensures that leadership teams and efforts are focused on enhancing and elevating western Pennsylvania through effective delivery of quality academic programs at each of PennWest's face-to-face campuses and online. One key to this success is the relationships between the institution, high schools and industry partnerships.

Dr. Anderson holds a Ph.D. in Business Administration from the University of Kentucky, a master's degree in Business Education from the University of West Georgia, a Bachelor of Science in Sociology from Utah State University, and an associate degree from Ricks College. In recognition of his leadership and impact, he was named one of Pennsylvania's most influential leaders in City & State's 2024 PA Fifty Over 50.

Dr. Anderson resides in Clarion with his wife, Kristy, and their son Bryce, while also spending time on the California and Edinboro campuses. He and Kristy are proud parents of seven children and grandparents to seven granddaughters (with one more on the way).

PRESIDENTIAL MEDALLION

Medallions, or chains of office, have served for centuries to commemorate special events or to recognize meritorious service or conduct. Chains of office are worn by a university president on ceremonial occasions as part of the regalia. The chains can be made of bronze, sterling silver or gold plate, and are usually anchored by a large medallion.

The University Seal forms the centerpiece medallion of the ceremonial chain that is worn by the president of Pennsylvania Western University.

The medallion pictured here was graciously given to University President Jonathan R. Anderson by the Foundation for California University of Pennsylvania, Clarion University Foundation, Inc., and Edinboro University Foundation at President Anderson's inauguration on December 6, 2024.



THE CEREMONIAL MACE

The ceremonial mace, a symbol of presidential authority, is carried at the head of the academic procession by the Mace Bearer. A gift of the Alumni Association, the mace was designed and executed by Professor Henry Katzwinkel and Dr. Seymour Blinderman, former chairman of the Art Department. It was first used at the inauguration of Edinboro State College by President Chester T. McNerney, in 1967.

The mace, 27 inches in length, is topped by a sterling silver sphere studded with circular cabochon rubies, secured by bezels. The collar of the mace is inlaid with ebony, alternated with silver relief fleur-de-lis design elements. Cultured pearls mounted in cups encircle the bottom of the collar. The shaft of the mace is composed of Brazilian rosewood sections, separated by sterling silver rings. The mace is terminated by a cast sterling silver finial; the five cultured pearls represent the existing curricula. The rib-like cone form is terminated by a small silver sphere symbolizing the world.

The metalworking processes incorporated in the ceremonial mace include turning, forging, inlaying, stone setting and lost wax centrifugal casting.

ACADEMIC ATTIRE

The academic attire worn at university ceremonies today in the United States dates back in its essential features to the Middle Ages. The oldest universities of northern Europe, such as Paris and Oxford, grew out of church schools. Students and faculty wore clerical garb, largely borrowed from the monastic dress of their day.

The head-covering of the academic costume developed out of the skull cap worn by the clergy in cold weather. In the universities, this skull cap acquired a point on top that gradually evolved into a tassel. In this country, it has been replaced by the familiar mortarboard, which still retains the medieval tassel.

The hood originally was worn over the head and otherwise dropped onto the shoulders, like a cowl. Today, each college has its distinctive colored hood-lining by which its graduates may be recognized.

GOWNS

Although the gown is more frequently black, certain universities have authorized the use of colored gowns. The bachelor's and master's gowns are fashioned from black serge. The yoke for the bachelor's gown is designed to be worn closed and features long, flowing and pointed sleeves. The master's gown is designed to be worn open or closed. Its sleeves are very long with square ends, and the front part has an arc cut away. The arms protrude through a slit at the elbow. The gown for the doctorate has bell-shaped sleeves, with velvet facing down the front and on three bars across the sleeves. The facing and crossbars of velvet may be of the color distinctive of the field to which the degree pertains.

HOODS

The hood is usually worn only for the master's and the doctorate. The doctor's hood is longer than the master's hood and has distinguishing panels. The college or university granting the degree is indicated by the color of the hood lining. The velvet trim of the hood indicates the field in which the degree was granted; those colors are listed on the next page.

CAPS

The standard cap is the mortarboard, usually the color of the gown. The tassel is black for the baccalaureate and master's degree and is worn over the left front quarter of the cap. The doctoral cap is indicated by a tassel of gold thread. Undergraduates wear the tassel on the right side of the cap until the moment the degree is conferred.

COLORS DISTINCTIVE OF THE DISCIPLINES AND PROFESSIONS

Only a single degree from a single institution should ever be indicated by a single garment. For all academic purposes, including trimmings of doctors' gowns, edgings of hoods, and tassels of caps, the colors associated with the different subjects are as follows:

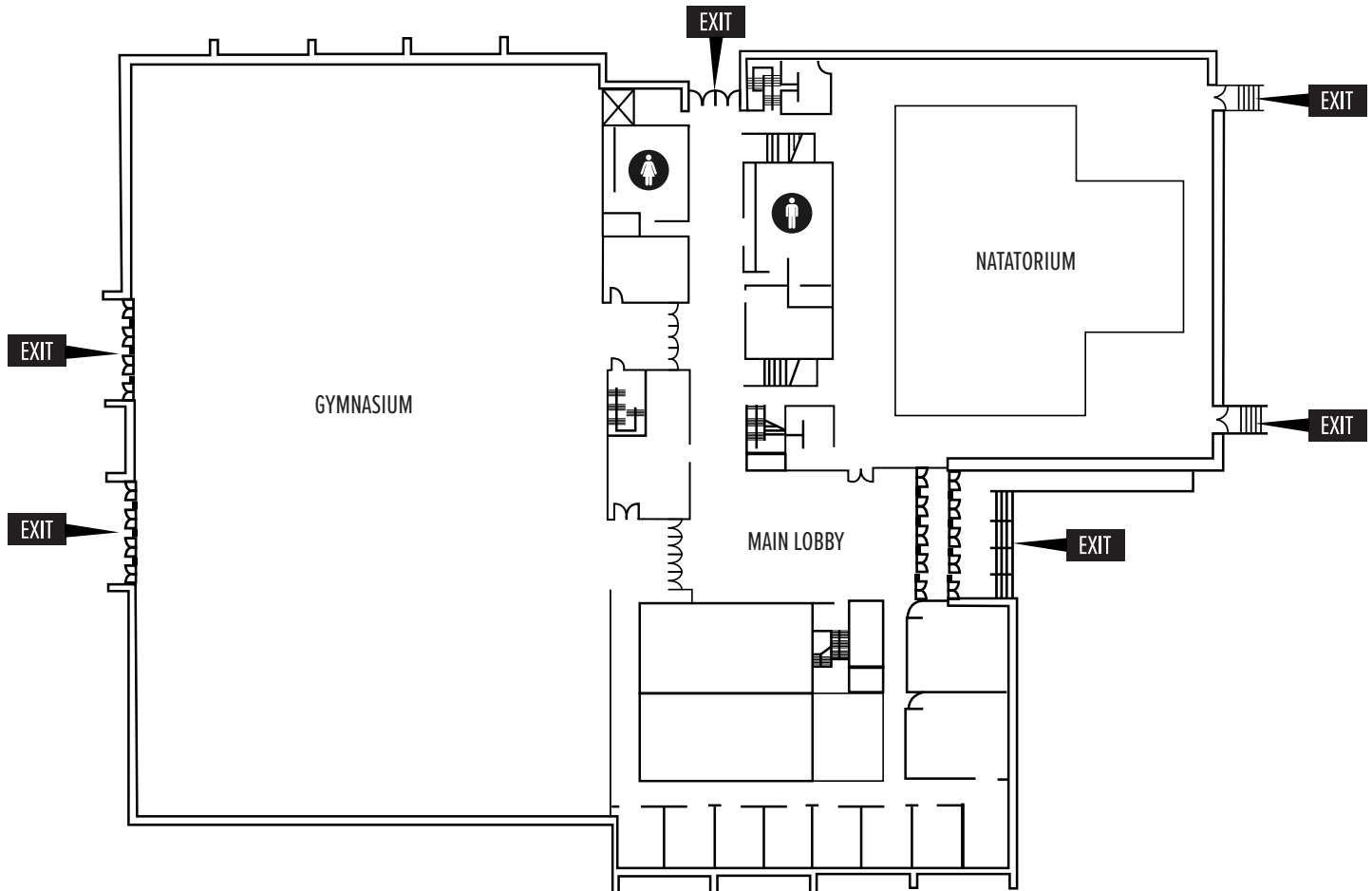
