MID-TERM GRADES & STUDENT SUPPORT

Thanks to your efforts, 2,475 low mid-term flags were raised for 1,574 students. When a D or lower is entered in Faculty Self Service, Starfish automatically emails students with steps to:

- ✓ How to schedule tutoring, supplemental instruction, or writing center appointments
- ✓ How to request help through Starfish
- ✓ How to follow up with the professor who issued the concern
- 📞 Follow-Up Outreach: Our team also makes one additional attempt to connect with each student to ensure they know what resources are available.

STRATEGIC ANALYTICS UPDATE
